

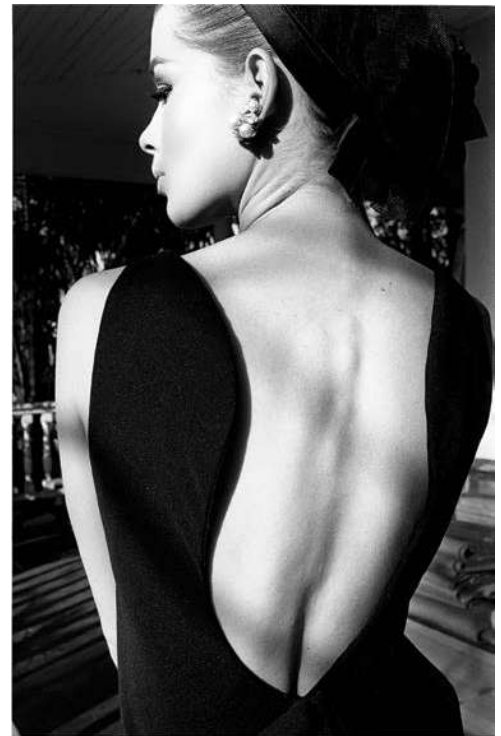


Stars in Paris
